The Sterling Energy Committee meeting was called to order at 7:14 pm by Chairman, Frank Bood.

Unfinished Business:

- a. **Assess the Existing Heating System at the Town Hall Building:** The Committee discussed the heat loss from the town hall causing ice dams on the roof.
- b. **World Energy Audit at the Town Hall:** In February Robert McLevy met with a representative from World Energy to conduct a brief survey of the town hall to suggest electric lighting energy savings. The representative suggested switching to LED lights. The estimated cost to do this would be \$13,000. Incentives and rebates would be approximately \$4,000. The town's share would be \$9,000. The estimated energy savings would be 6,000 Kwh/ year. It would take approximately 7.5 years for the energy savings to cover the cost of the upgrades.
- c. **School Bus Fuel Consumption:** No new information.
