Town of Sterling Invitation to Bid

The Town of Sterling is seeking a proposal to tack coat and overlay the following:

Approximately 750 linear feet on Railroad Avenue from start line marked on the road surface with yellow paint to the end line at CL&P Pole #335 in a northerly direction. The road is approximately twenty feet (20') in width.

Approximately 1,350 linear feet on Deerfield Drive from Route 14A to a stop line marked on the road surface with yellow paint in a southerly direction. The road is approximately twenty feet (20') in width.

Approximately 2,350 linear feet on Gibson Lane in its entirety. The road is approximately twenty feet (20') in width.

Approximately 10,100 linear feet on Calvin French Road from the concrete block garage to Sawmill Hill Road in a northerly direction. The road is approximately twenty feet (20') in width.

Approximately 3,700 linear feet on Sawmill Hill Road from a start line marked on the road surface with yellow paint at the Killingly Town Line to the Rhode Island State Line in a southerly direction. The road is approximately twenty feet (20') in width.

The tack coat must be applied along the entirety of the road section(s) to be overlaid, and the overlay shall consist of a single lift of one and one-half inches (1 ½") of compacted Class 1 bituminous concrete, making sure that all ends are properly keyed with the old surface.

Sealed bids shall be accepted until 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at the Sterling Town Hall, Office of the Selectman, PO Box 157, 1183 Plainfield Pike, Oneco, CT 06373. Bids will be publicly opened and read at an open public meeting on Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at 5:45 p.m. in the Conference Room at the Sterling Town Hall, by the Board of Selectmen.

The Town of Sterling reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.
