

**Town of Sterling  
Invitation to Bid

The Town of Sterling is seeking proposals in the form of three (3) individual bids. Pricing should be itemized by Part and Sub-Part and can be awarded separately or in total.

Infrastructure Cabling System Replacement

Bid should consist of two line items priced separately. One for the install of new cabling infrastructure with Belden System 2400 CAT6 or 6+ that has been engineered, designed, and installed by a certified Belden System 2400 installer. The second is for the removal of the old cabling infrastructure. See CAT6 Line Drop(s), CAT6 Line Removal(s) Diagrams, Cabling Scope of Work, and Cabling Specifications attachments.

Network Switch Replacement

Replacement of network switches including three (3) each WS-C2960XR-24PD-L, CAB-16AWG-AC=, C2960X-STACK=, CAB-STK-E-3M=. One (1) each of the following items: SOPHOS SG 210 UTM and three (3) year total protect. See Network Scope attachment.

Network Server Replacement

Replacement of the current server with a Dell PowerEdge VRTX. See Server Scope of Replacement attachment.
