Drainage improvement project

The Town of Sterling, Board of Selectmen are seeking bids from interested companies for the materials needed to make drainage improvements to Gibson Hill Road, Sterling, CT. Material delivery, as specified below, shall be included as part of the lump sum price. This project is anticipated to be conducted in August of 2017.

Delivery: All pipe shall be delivered to the Sterling Town Garage directly behind 225 Main Street, Sterling, CT. All other materials shall be delivered at the time of construction to the work site at various locations on Gibson Hill Road. Town Staff will direct the delivery drivers to the various locations for delivery of the flared ends and leaching catch basin.
