The Sterling Water Pollution Control Authority, at their meeting held on May 16, 2018 voted to adopt new fees for the approved Sewer Use Charge for all residential and commercial properties to be effective July 1, 2018 billing. A complete copy of the adopted schedule was filed with the Town Clerk, Sterling, Connecticut, on May 17, 2018.

Be it resolved by the Sterling Water Pollution Control Authority in accordance with Provisions of Section 7-255 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, that: Effective July 1, 2018, a Sewer Use Charge of \$450.00 per year per EDU (equivalent dwelling unit) shall be levied on all properties connected to the Sterling Municipal Sewage System. The Sewer Use Charge shall be due and payable in two semi-annual payments due July 1 and January 1 of each calendar year. Sewer Use Charges not paid within thirty (30) days of the due date shall thereupon be delinquent and shall bear interest from the due date until such Sewer Use Charge is paid in full. Interest shall be computed in the manner provided in Section 7-258 and 12-146 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended. Any person(s) wishing to appeal this decision may do so within twenty-one (21) days of the filing date with the Town Clerk.
