

**Town of Sterling  
Sterling Community School  
Invitation to Bid  
September 20, 2018**

The Town of Sterling is seeking proposals to furnish and install a new 150 kW generator. Please refer to site plans for specific details.

The proposed bid shall include the installation of one (1) new 150kW generator, including equipment pad, reinforced with re-bar, and all of the interconnecting conduit and wire connected to existing ATS. The electrical contractor will be responsible for the purchase and installation including all labor, material and equipment necessary for the installation of the proposed standby generator.

Scope to include: Site work associated with the installation of the generator including excavation, trenching, pavement removal and disposal, restoration of all non paved areas, (i.e. loamed and seeded), and pavement replacement. Processed gravel shall be compacted to ninety-eight (98%) minimum, and a five (5) inch layer of one and one fourth (1¼) feet minus crushed stone over heavy duty landscape fabric and to install a six (6) foot chain link fence enclosure to match existing fence associated with the installation of the generator (see site plan E102).

Sealed bids, clearly marked "**Bid – Generator**" will be received until 12:00 noon on Wednesday, October 3, 2018 at the Office of the First Selectman, Sterling Town Hall/Municipal Building, 1183 Plainfield Pike, P.O. Box 157, Oneco, CT 06373-0157. **A pre-bid meeting will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 26, 2018 at the Sterling Community School, 251 Sterling Road, (Route 14) Sterling, CT.**
