## Town of Sterling Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964

The Town of Sterling does not discriminate in the provision of services, the administration of its programs, or contractual agreements. The Town of Sterling seeks to fully carry out its responsibilities under the Title VI Regulations.

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the grounds of race, color or national origin in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance. Title VI provides that No person shall on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any programs covered by the Regulations.
