- **Masks required at all NDDH vaccination clinics**

**Note new guidelines for time recommended between doses:**

Vaccines Available	For Ages	# of shots in primary series and time between 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose	WHO can get a COVID-19 BOOSTER and when you can get it
<b>Pfizer-BioNTech</b>	<b>5-11</b>	Two (2) shots 3 weeks apart	Not available for ages 5-11
<b>Pfizer-BioNTech</b>	<b>12+</b>	Two (2) shots <b>3-8 weeks</b> apart**	Ages 12+ At least 5 months after a 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose of Pfizer
<b>Moderna</b>	<b>18+</b>	Two (2) shots <b>4-8 weeks</b> apart**	Ages 18+ At least 5 months after a 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose of Moderna
<b>Johnson &amp; Johnson</b>	<b>18+</b>	1	Ages 18+ At least 2 months after a J & J vaccine

\*\*A **shorter interval** (3 weeks for Pfizer-BioNTech; 4 weeks for Moderna) between the first and second doses remains the recommended interval for: people who are moderately to severely immunocompromised; adults ages 65 years and older; and others who need rapid protection due to increased concern about community transmission or risk of severe disease.
