To be eligible for the 2024 Renters' Rebate program you must have been at least 65 years old or totally disabled as of 12/31/2023, have been a resident of CT for at least one year, and meet the income requirements for the program:

To complete the application, you will need:

- 1) Proof of your 2023 income including:
 - o SSA 1099 from Social Security
 - o statements of dividends or interest earned
 - o pension and /or wage statements.
- 2) Proof of your housing utility expenses, including all bills and receipts for sewer and water, electricity, gas, oil or other heating expense, even if it paid for in full or in part with energy assistance. A calendar year 2023 statement from your utility company is acceptable.
- 3) Receipts for all monthly rent paid in 2023.

If you filed a 2023 federal income tax return, include a copy as well as a copy of your SSA-1099 from Social Security.

You must submit proof of your 2023 income and expenses to the assessor before your plan can be certified. This proof *may* consist of:

- → Federal Income Tax Return
- → Bank statements showing interest earned
- → Statements for trust accounts or dividend earnings
- → Form SSA-1099 from the Social Security Administration Or RRB-1099R from the Railroad Retirement Board

You must also present proof of:
