Approval of Minutes: J. Firlik made a motion, seconded by L. Cooper to approve the 10/7/2015 regular meeting minutes as presented. All voted in favor of the motion. Unfinished Business:

- Commission Vacancies (Economic Development Commission, Sterling Recreation Authority, & Zoning Board of Appeals): No new information. L. Cooper made a motion, seconded by J. Firlik to table this item to the next meeting. All voted in favor of the motion.
- b. Insulation for Sterling Municipal Building, 1183 Plainfield Pike, Oneco, CT: J. Gustavson reported that Frank Bood, Chairman of the Energy Committee has not been in the office and he will send information regarding energy audit companies as soon as possible. L. Cooper made a motion, seconded by J. Firlik to table this item to the next meeting. All voted in favor of the motion,
- c. Land Use Office Mailing Planning a Construction Project: D. - Gibson Park, LLC (f/n Sterling Park Campground): (This was listed incorrectly on the agenda as New Business). D. Sorrentino, Zoning Enforcement Officer reported that he spoke to Kari Olsen, Town attorney, clarifying his mistake that representatives from Gibson Park, LLC would be at the Selectmen's meeting on 10/7/2015. K. Olsen will recheck her notes from the February meeting before proceeding to see if a written stipulation was put in place with Attorney Block. Gibson Park, LLC does not have to be notified again of the violation and the right of a hearing is waived. The campground is in violation of the Town's Mobile Parks and Trailer Ordinance as well as zoning regulations. The Town has been trying to address this issue since 2008 and campground residents have been told many times to vacate the premises. K. Olsen will send a second notice to the campground and D. Sorrentino will gather and forward requested information to K. Olsen who will send notice to the campground. L. Cooper made a motion, seconded by J. Firlik to table this item to the next meeting.
