## April 6, 2016

The special meeting of the Sterling Board of Finance was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Chairman David Shippee. Other members' present-Bruce Lindberg, Dale Clark, Neil Cook, Robert Lassan, and Neil Delmonico (7:10 p.m.)

Staff present-Russell Gray, Lincoln Cooper, John Firlik, and Joyce Gustavson.

Also present-Brenda Needham.

**Approval of Minutes:** N. Cook made a motion, seconded by D. Clark to approve the minutes of the 3/9/2016 monthly meeting as written and presented. All voted in favor of the motion.

D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Cook to move Unfinished Business, Item d. ahead of Unfinished Business, Item a. All voted in favor of the motion.

## **Unfinished Business:**

**d.** Consider & Act on the Board of Education's Proposed 2016-2017 Budget: D. Shippee stated at the 3/9/2016 meeting that this item was tabled until all the revenues were available. The goal is to present a zero mil increase to the public. The Board of Education's total 2016-2017 proposed budget request was for \$8,109,459 and they have been asked to reduce their budget by \$61,690 for a revised proposed budget request in the amount of \$8,047,769. Estimated Revenue is \$3,357,886 leaving \$4,689,883 to be raised by taxes. D. Shippee stated this budget represents 21.17 mils using \$221,551 as the worth of one mil.

D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Cook to approve the Board of Education's revised proposed 2016-2017 budget in the amount of \$8,047,769 as it was presented this evening. All voted in favor of the motion.

The total estimated mil rate would be 31.60 mils which is a zero mil increase over last year.

a. <u>Tax Collector's Grand Ratebook Balance Sheet Report:</u> The report was submitted and reviewed.

**b.** <u>I.T. Upgrades for the Sterling Municipal Building:</u> D. Shippee reported that three (3) people, possibly four (4) have volunteered to serve on the Computer Assessment Committee. The Committee held its first meeting on Monday, 3/21/2016 and will meet the first and third Wednesday of the month with the project being broken down into four segments; 1) Nutmeg Network, 2) Hardware updates, 3) Software updates, and 4) RFP's (Request for Proposal). D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Delmonico to remove this item from the agenda until the Committee has completed their findings. All voted in favor of the motion.</u>

**c.** <u>Confirm Budget Schedule for 2016-2017</u>: J. Gustavson confirmed the following dates for the proposed 2016-2017 proposed budgets:

The **Public Hearing** on the 2016-2017 Proposed Board of Education and Board of Selectmen Budget is scheduled for Wednesday, April 27, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

The **Town Meeting** for the 2016-2017 proposed budgets is scheduled for Wednesday, May 11, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

The **Referendum** for the 2016-2017 proposed budgets is scheduled for Wednesday, May 18, 2016 from noon to 8:00 p.m.

All meetings are scheduled to be held in the gym at the Sterling Town Hall, 1183 Plainfield Pike, Oneco, CT.

## **New Business:**

**a.** <u>Appointment of Auditor for FY Ending 6/30/2016</u>: D. Shippee reported that in April 2011 the Board of Finance appointed the audit firm for a five (5) year appointment. In April of 2015, the audit firm was appointed for one (1) year. D. Shippee stated that a five (5) year appointment is too long and he would like to see the audit firm be appointed for a three (3) year term for FY ending 6/30/2016, 6/30/2017, and 6/30/2018</u>. Marcia Marien of O'Connor Davies, LLP will be contacted to submit an "Audit Engagement Letter" for a three (3) year term to the Board of Finance for consideration. D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Cook to table this item to the next meeting. All voted in favor of the motion.

**b.** <u>Consider & Act on Suspense List Previously Submitted:</u> Anna Gagner, CCMA, Revenue Collector submitted the Suspense List for action by the Board of Finance. D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Delmonico to approve the transfer of certain uncollected taxes to the Suspense Tax Book as follows: Motor Vehicle Suspense List 2013, FY 7/1/2015-6/30/2016 in the amount of \$28,473.62; Motor Vehicle Supplement Suspense List 2013, FY 7/1/2015-6/30/2016 in the amount of \$5,268,10; Personal Property Suspense List 2013, FY 7/1/2015-6/30/2016 in the amount of \$16,151.44. All voted in favor of the motion.</u>

**Any Other Business:** D. Shippee stated that we have a serious problem as the audit is not completed. In March, 2016, R. Gray signed a fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) extension request for filing, which is 99.99 percent attributed to the school. Resolving this matter was discussed at length, as well as, scheduling a Tri-Board meeting and having a forensic audit done. D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Cook to hire an independent forensic auditor to examine and evaluate the Board of Education's financials for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and Fiscal Year 2015-2016. All voted in favor of the motion. A Tri-Board meeting has been scheduled for Wednesday, April 13, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at the Sterling Municipal Building, 1183 Plainfield Pike, Oneco, CT.

**Adjournment:** D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Delmonico to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. All voted in favor of the motion.
