April 13, 2016

Call to Order: An emergency meeting of the Sterling Board of Finance was called to order at 7:20 p.m. by Chairman David Shippee. Other Members' present – Neil Cook, Robert Lassan, Neil Delmonico, Bruce Lindberg and Dale Clark

Meeting Purpose: On April 6, 2016 at the special Board of Finance meeting, a motion was made to have a forensic audit performed on the Board of Education budget. During the Tri-Board meeting, preceding this emergency meeting of the Board of Finance, Town auditor Marcia Marien, CPA, made the recommendation that in lieu of a forensic audit we increase testing on the 2014/2015 budget.

New Business:

- **a.** A motion was made by D. Clark and seconded by N. Cook that the previous motion to perform a forensic audit be rescinded. All voted in favor of the motion.
- **b.** A motion was made by N. Delmonico and seconded by N. Cook to have the office of O'Conner Davies, LLP expand the current audit to include the following:
 - 1. Increase the testing of individual disbursements through the education accounting system by selecting additional disbursements to test (in varying sizes) through the following funds: General Fund, Grant Fund, Cafeteria and Student Activity Funds.
 - 2. Increase the testing of payroll by obtaining the database in Excel and use "Active Data" to compare salaries, by person.
 - 3. Compare the current year expenditures to the expenditures in the prior 2 years and analytically review the details of any expense account (that varies by more than \$25,000 and 10%).
 - 4. Report any discrepancies to determine if we should further expand the audit. All voted in favor of the motion.
- **c.** A motion was made by N. Delmonico and seconded by N. Cook to have Cheryl LaFlamme-Miller of C.L. Services CPA work with the Board of Education and the Board of Selectmen for the remainder of the 2015/2016 budget to ensure the budget remains balanced through June of 2016. All voted in favor of the motion.

Adjournment: D. Clark made a motion, seconded by N. Cook to adjourn 7:25pm. All voted in favor of the motion.
