<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> L. Cooper made a motion, seconded by J. Firlik to approve the 5/2/2018 meeting minutes as presented. All voted in favor of the motion.

**Unfinished Business:**

1. To adopt the budget of the Board of Education once approved by the Board of Finance and to appropriate said sums of monies for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2019.

2. To adopt the budget of the Board of Selectmen once approved by the Board of Finance and to appropriate said sums of monies for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2019.

3. To adopt the Local Capital Improvement Plan and Budget once approved by the Board of Finance and to appropriate said sums of monies for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2019.

**b.** Consider & Act on Paving Proposals – 1) Pavement Overlay-Gibson Hill Road; 2) Full Depth Reclamation-Gibson Hill Road; and 3) Pavement Overlay-Snake Meadow Hill Road: The Board of Selectmen received the following bid: Charles Pasteryak Jr., Inc., 20 N. Burnham Highway, Lisbon, CT 06351 for 1) Pavement Overlay with an average compacted depth of two and one half (2.5) compacted inches of Class 1 bituminous concrete on Gibson Hill Road in the amount of \$869,940; 2) Full Depth Reclamation with an average compacted depth of overlay of two and one half (2.5) compacted inches of Class 1 bituminous concrete to reclaim road base to be graded and compacted in the amount of \$1,274,515; 3) Snake Meadow Hill Road Pavement Overlay with an average compacted depth of two and one half (2.5) compacted depth of two and one half (2.5) compacted in the amount of \$1,274,515; 3) Snake Meadow Hill Road Pavement Overlay with an average compacted depth of two and one half (2.5) compacted in the amount of \$1,274,515; 3) Snake Meadow Hill Road Pavement Overlay with an average compacted depth of two and one half (2.5) compacted inches of Class 1 bituminous concrete inches of Class 1 bituminous concrete

An alternative bid to Option 2, Full Depth Reclamation for Gibson Hill Road with an average compacted depth of overlay of two and one half (2.5) compacted inches of Class 1 bituminous concrete to consist of one and one half (1.5) inches bituminous concrete class 1 binder and one and one half (1.5) inches bituminous concrete class 1 surface course in the amount of \$1,099,203. L. Cooper stated that this project did not go out to bid as Charles Pasteryak, Jr., Inc. is listed on the State of Connecticut, State Contracting Portal. L. Cooper made a motion, seconded by J. Firlik to award the bid to Charles Pasteryak Jr., Inc., 20 N. Burnham Highway, Lisbon, CT 06351for full depth reclamation on Gibson Hill Road to reclaim road base to be graded and compacted in the amount of \$1,274,515 and pavement overlay on Snake Meadow Hill Road with an average compacted depth of two and one half (2.5) compacted inches of Class 1 bituminous concrete in the amount of \$62,510. All voted in favor of the motion.

<u>Any Other Business:</u> **Consider & Act on Request to Celebrating Agriculture:** L. Cooper stated that he received a letter dated April 2018 from Linda Auger, Chairman, Fundraising Committee - Celebrating Agriculture. September 22, marks the 18<sup>th</sup> annual Celebrating Agriculture event; a fun filled educational day for the whole family and he would like the Board of Selectmen to consider sponsoring the event, as the Town is an agricultural community. J. Firlik made a motion, seconded by L. Cooper to approve the request for \$250 - Silver Sponsor to Celebrating Agriculture. All voted in favor of the motion. <u>Adjournment:</u> L.
