Raymond and Steven Weidele have made an offer to purchase 50 Main Street for \$100,000 cash and land sold to them by the town in 2013,390 Sterling Road, aka Revere Site (parcel B). U. Blinkhorn to recommend to the Selectmen that it is in the best interest both economically and financially for the Town of Sterling and should accept the offer of \$100,000 cash and the land at 390 Sterling Road.
