The proposal will consist of rewiring the existing emergency lights (with battery backup) to 277 volt circuits powered from the generator panel located in the main electric room. Currently, approximately 50 lights are connected to the generator and 200 are not. R. McLevy submitted a preliminary scope of the work, including its purpose. The committee determined to move forward with the scope of the work as presented.
