Subject: Proposed Gravel Removal Operation / Tilcon
Route 14
Town of Sterling

The Department of Transportation (Department) has reviewed your latest plans for the above-noted subject received January 28, 2019, entitled "Proposed Gravel Removal Operation / Tilcon" dated February 3, 2009, and last revised July 18, 2018, and "Sightline Demonstration" dated January 23, 2019. Your submittal/application to work within the State right of way or perform work that may affect State property is denied based on the following comments:

1. Proof of Town approval must be submitted.
2. The sight line for this area of roadway will be based on the 85th% speeds. The minimum required sight distance is 765'; the Intersection Sight Distances (ISD) must be measured 15' from the edge of the road, at an eye height of 7.6 feet for the exiting (tractor-trailer-type) vehicle, and an object height of 3.5 feet. Revised plans must show and be labeled from this point for the proposed driveway.
3. A 30" Stop sign and a 12" Stop bar must be installed in the sight driveway.
4. Please provide a cubic yard estimate of material that will need to be removed from the State right of way in order to achieve the required sight line.
5. Please revise plans showing the radius of the proposed drive.

When you resubmit, please provide two sets of plans, 40 scale or larger, reflecting the above-noted comments. Please note that any resubmission may generate additional comments and concerns and in no way guarantees the issuance of an encroachment permit. An encroachment permit must be obtained prior to performing any work within or affecting the highway right of way. **If you have any questions in regard to this matter, please contact Mr. Daniel McBride of this office at (860) 823-3114, or by email at daniel.mcbride@ct.gov.**
